THE ORIGINS OF THE PILGRIM PRECEPTORS

The early part of this account was told to Andrew Stephenson by the late John Edward Nowell Walker, a former Grand Master who died shortly before his 90th birthday in 1990. The remainder is from Andrew's recollections.

The acting profession has always been a precarious one. The Play is all important, and nobody has ever been able to predict what makes a Play a success with the public. Even Shakespeare wrote failures, performed today as 'curiosities'. In this country it is the custom for producers to try out new Plays in selected Provincial Theatres with the authors re-writing parts of the script in the light of audience reaction. Only if the final version appears to appeal do they then perform in London. The actors do their best, but even the inclusion of, say Laurence Olivier, in the cast is no guarantee of success.

In former times, if the cast was lucky, the Manager would pay in advance for their hotel accommodation until the end of the projected visit (usually the weekend) and give the actors rail tickets for their return to London on a specific day (usually Monday morning). If the tour was a flop there would be no money available to pay wages. Many 'ditties' are recited at actors' reunions setting out the hardships which all may have suffered, even the stars.

During the late 1870s three actors found themselves idle and forced to remain in their hotel in Manchester for a long and typically wet weekend because the play in which they had been performing suddenly 'folded'. All three were members of the Craft and the Royal Arch, and possibly other Masonic Orders. During their visits to the North they had visited a number of Masonic Halls and had access to the libraries these places had in those days; the one at Formby was given particular mention. On this wet weekend in Manchester, perhaps to while away the time, they conceived the idea of using some of the information they had found to develop a Masonic ceremony called The Pilgrim Preceptors. By the end of the weekend they had produced a manuscript version which was later polished and typed. However, this was a private enterprise and they made no attempt to invite others to join them or to see the ceremony performed. One of the actors was named LeFre. He prospered and, in his very old age, discovered his Craft Lodge would be celebrating its centenary on his own 100th birthday. The members elected him to be Master for that special year, but sadly he died just three week before his Installation.

This Worshipful Brother LeFre had a son, Eric LeFre, also an actor and a member of the Craft. Amongst his father's papers Eric inherited the original manuscript and the typescript revision developed by the three thespians in Manchester. Sadly Eric did little with these documents until, after much pestering, an elderly Eric conferred, by Obligation, the Order on John Edward Nowell Walker for a fee of a halfpenny in the 1970s, gave him the script and verbally all rights to the Order. Within a year Eric too had died, whereon John Walker "initiated" by Obligation five Companions after a meeting of the August Order of Light held in South London, namely Captain Michael Penrose, Andrew Stephenson, George Duke, John Jary and Howard Stokes. Jary photocopied the typescript and George Duke attempted to set out the floor cloth using purple ribbon and pins, but without success.

The main problem was the script itself. The actors had abbreviated a large number of words to their first letter followed by dots; unfortunately the number of dots did not always match the missing letters! Whilst they had produced a two page key these six members found that the constant reference to the key made them become frustrated and they abandoned their attempt to rehearse the ceremony. Even using the key they quickly found the many of the abbreviated words were far from secret, but ones in common use and already set out in full in other well established masonic rituals. By this time John Walker, with the assistance of other members, was becoming heavily involved in the reconstruction of the Order of St. Thomas of Acon and eventually he appointed Howard Stokes as Grand Master of the Pilgrim Preceptors. Unfortunately Howard's eyesight was failing and he made no attempt to work the Order.

By 1984 the Temple of the Order of Light which met in South London had grown to 23 members and was well established. One feature of their meetings was the dining, and despite its Yorkshire title of High Tea, it was in fact dinner and was cooked by one of the members. The conversations during these meals was lively and during the September 1984 dinner a newish member, one Brian Slater,

brother of John Slater the actor, and himself involved in the entertainment industry as a boffin in special and electrical effects with London weekend Television; Brian had tried to interest John Walker into using special effects, such as dry ice and other theatrical effects in masonic ceremonies. Somehow the conversation moved to the mentioning of the Order of the Pilgrim Preceptors, whereon Brian and another member Benson F. Catt, a City of London accountant, persuaded Howard Stokes into reviving the Order. This he did on 8th December, 1984 when Ben Catt, Brian Slater and Alan Perry were obligated into the Order; Howard handed over copies of the ritual to them with the request that they devise a practical way of working it. He also appointed Ben Catt as Grand Secretary on the spot with the responsibility of structuring a proper Masonic Order.

Brian and Ben studied the ritual and with Brian's knowledge of scripts and special effects he was able to work out simple 'props' were needed; these he produced. Early during their work on the ritual received from Howard Stokes it was discovered that a page was missing; mention was made in the key but there was no matching page. Through research they found that John Jary who had been given copies of the early script but had died some years earlier and his papers had been destroyed. Brian and Ben then reconstructed the missing page and produced new copies of the ritual with some, though not all, of the abbreviated words restored in full. On 8th March 1986, a full rehearsal of the ritual took place followed by a full meeting of the Order with Howard Stokes presiding and Companion Norman Pitt being admitted; the first time the ceremony, or rather ceremonies for there are two, were worked.. At the same meeting five current members of the Order were also admitted to the secrets of the Chair. It was then arranged that the Order would meet twice a year on the morning of two of the four regular meetings of the Order of Light.

Following this first meeting Howard Stokes announced his resignation from the office of Grand Master of the Order, feeling that the progress made had established a firm future for the Order of the Pilgrim Preceptors. Alas Brian Slater died very suddenly at the age of 56 in January, 1987 and Norman Pitt shortly thereafter. At a second meeting, on 5th September, 1987 John Walker became Grand Master and was duly installed in that high office. Andrew Stephenson became Deputy Grand Master. Sadly John Walker died in November 1991 and on 4th September, 1993 Andrew Stephenson was Installed as Grand Master.

Until the 1990s almost all members of the Order had been recruited from those who attended the Order of Light. By 1998 membership had expanded to include a number of members from Kent, and on 13th June, 1998 a new Preceptory, called St. Augustine Preceptory was consecrated. Between the admission of Norman Pitt in March 1986 and August 2000 membership had reached over 50.

As the years have passed changes to the Order have been made. For example the title of units has changed from Preceptory to Conclave, a full set of Regulations adopted and most importantly the original unit which had hitherto governed the Order became a Sovereign Grand Conclave which immediately established a time immemorial Conclave, called the St. Andrew Conclave, to carry on the work of admission of new members from the London area, and sometimes elsewhere in the UK. The Order has continued to expand and on 25th January, 2003 a third unit was established at York called the Athelstan Conclave. This was followed by a fourth on 25th October of the same year, this time at Radlett in Hertfordshire called Prince Edwin Conclave.

In 2006 Andrew Stephenson announced that he was emigrating to New Zealand and in his stead he nominated Benson F Catt to be Grand Master. In September, 2006 Ben was Installed into that high office and for the first time a full team of Grand Officers was appointed. Further Conclaves were consecrated on:

5th May, 2007 the **Holy Well Conclave No 4** to meet at Mold
9th October 2008 **St. Laurence Conclave No 5** to meet at Southend
17th November, 2008 **St. Richard Conclave No 6** to meet at Uckfield
9th September, 2009 **St. Petroc Conclave No 7** to meet at Crediton.

On 14th February, 2010 the Order make took its first step to becoming international when the **Mayflower Conclave, No 8**, was consecrated with a peripatetic Warrant to meet within the United States of America.

Late in February 2011 Ben Catt announced that for health reasons he could no longer continue as Grand Master and had nominated Stephen M. Ayres, JP as his successor. On 19th March 2011 Stephen was Installed as Grand Master, to become Most Illustrious Brother Stephen M. Ayres, in a full Installation Ceremony. Ralph Wheeler who for the previous five years had been Grand Secretary was appointed as Deputy Grand Master; only the second DGM within the Order.

Since becoming Grand Master, M. Ill. Bro. Stephen Ayres consecrated 8 Conclaves in his first 3 years :

28th June, 2011 the **Hadrian Conclave No 9** to meet at Chester-le-Street
 24th August, 2011 the **Palatine Conclave No 10** at Leyland
 29th November, 2011 the **Londinium Conclave No 11** meeting at Mark Masons Hall in London
 21st June, 2012 the **Cantium Conclave No 12** meeting at Canterbury
 24th November, 2012 the **Portus Adruni Conclave No 13** to meet at Havant
 3rd April, 2013 the **Mercia Conclave No 14** to meet at Kings Heath, Birmingham
 19th September, 2013 the **Pride of Surrey Conclave No 15** to meet at Sutton in Surrey
 27th June, 2014 the **Deoraby Conclave No 16** to meet at Long Eaton.

October 2014 saw the Installation of a new Deputy Grand Master, in the person of R. ll. Bro. James J. Field at a special meeting of Grand Conclave. R. ll. Bro. James was succeeded as Grand Marshal by V. Ill. Bro. Jonathan C. Roberts.

On the 8th August 2015 the **Conclave of the Angles No 17** was Consecrated to meet in Bury St. Edmund, East Anglia, with the Grand Superintendent in and over Suffolk taking the Chair.

Ralph Wheeler who for the previous five years had been Grand Secretary was appointed as Deputy Grand Master; only the second DGM within the Order.

At the meeting of Grand Conclave on 30th April 2016 the Grand Master re-appointed R. Ill. Bro. James J. Field as his Deputy and R. Ill. Leslie Bales as Regional Governor for certain Conclaves meeting in the north of England. He then appointed the first Assistant Grand Master of the Order in the person of R. Ill. Bro. Roger O'Brien who had hitherto been the Regional Governor for certain Conclaves meeting the south east of England. R. Ill. Bro. Roger O'Brien will be the key link point for Conclaves not under the superintendence of a Regional Governor. R. Ill. Bro. Brian Prevett was appointed as Regional Governor for the South eastern Counties of England. The year saw the Consecration of three further Conclaves :

25th Jun, the **Kernow Conclave No. 18** to meet at Wadebridge in Cornwall
 28th June, the **Lady Eleanor Conclave No. 19** to meet at Macclesfield
 22nd September, the **Gippelwich Conclave No. 20** to meet at Ipswich

At the 2017 meeting of Grand Conclave, R.Ill.Bro James Field retired as Deputy Grand Master and was replaced by R.Ill.Bro Roger O'Brien. R.Ill.Bro William Hamilton-Hinds was appointed as the Assistant Grand Master, R.Ill.Bro Thomas Auber appointed at Regional Governor for the Eastern Counties and V.Ill.Bro Louis Keats was appointed Grand Chaplain and R.Ill.Bro Eric Bourne appointed as Grand Secretary. It was further decided that in future the Annual Meeting of Grand Conclave would be on the last Saturday in June each year.

Two further Conclaves were Consecrated in late 2017.

29th August, the **Rex Britannicus Conclave No. 21** to meet at Leicester
 13th November, the **Litus Saxonum Conclave No. 22** to meet at Eastbourne

In October 2017, the Grand Master, at a Meeting of Mercia Conclave No 14, in Birmingham, appointed and Installed R.Ill.Bro. Raymond Ellis as Regional Governor for the Heart of England.

2018 saw Grand Conclave move out of London for its Annual Meeting, to Freemasons' Hall. Leicester. Attendance at the Meeting and the following Luncheon was almost 100% greater than when in London.

R.Ill.Bro Charles Aspinell was appointed Assistant Grand Master upon the retirement of R.Ill.Bro William Hamilton-Hinds, who for his many years of service, as Grand Secretary and subsequently Assistant Grand Master, was appointed a Past Deputy Grand Master.

R.Ill.Bro Stephen Priestley was appointed Regional Governor for the Northern Counties in place of R.Ill.Bro Lesley Bale who was re-appointed as Regional Governor for the United States of America.

Two further Conclaves were Consecrated.

2nd August 2018, the **Bishop's Lynn Conclave No. 23** to meet at Kings Lynn.
 19th September, the **Titus Caesar Conclave 0** to meet at Mark Masons Hall.
 The Grand Master to be the permanent Illustrious Preceptor of the Conclave with a Deputy Illustrious Preceptor being designated by the Grand Master and installed in September.

Plans are now well in hand for 4 new Conclaves in the United States of America, all to be consecrated at Philadelphia in February 2019 and a Conclave in Greece to be Consecrated in Athens in the spring of 2019.

It is hoped that in the following 12 months, further expansion may be forthcoming with interest being expressed in forming new Conclaves in Oxford, Bournemouth, Devonshire, Somerset, Lancashire and Yorkshire.

Data Protection Policy

Definitions

ORDER means The Masonic Order of Pilgrim Preceptors.

PERSONAL DATA means any recorded information which identifies a living individual.

HEAD OF THE ORDER means the Grand Master.

UNIT(S) OF THE ORDER means Conclave(s).

ADMINISTRATION means administrative Officers of Grand Conclave, Regions and Provinces.

CONSTITUTIONS means the Constitutions and Regulations for the Government of the ORDER in force from time to time.

HANDBOOK means the Calendar and Directory published each year.

This data protection policy regulates how the ORDER processes and stores PERSONAL DATA of its members by the ADMINISTRATION. It applies to all officers, members and volunteers of the ORDER. Its purpose is to ensure that the ORDER complies with the law and with high data protection standards.

1. Purposes

As a membership organisation the ORDER processes, retains and shares PERSONAL DATA of members for the purposes set out in the Data Protection Notice. Where the ORDER employs or contracts with a member it may also process, retain and share PERSONAL DATA of that member for all lawful purposes related to that employment or contractual relationship.

The ORDER shall not collect or store PERSONAL DATA of members for any other purposes.

2. Appointment of a Data Protection Officer

The ORDER shall appoint a Data Protection Officer who will oversee compliance with data protection law and will act as a point of contact for members and the Information Commissioner's Office (the "ICO"). The Data Protection Officer shall have a direct line of communication with the HEAD OF THE ORDER and shall have, or shall undergo training to ensure that he has, knowledge of data protection law and practices.

3. Members' data rights

A member may request that the Data Protection Officer:

- a. Provides him with a copy of all PERSONAL DATA that the ORDER holds about him. The Data Protection Officer shall promptly provide a copy of all information required to be disclosed by law.
- b. Rectifies any incorrect PERSONAL DATA held by the ORDER about him. The Data Protection Officer shall promptly consider such a request and respond to it in accordance with the law.
- c. Stop the ORDER from some or all of its processing of his PERSONAL DATA. The Data Protection Officer shall promptly consider such an objection and respond to it in accordance with the law

4. Deletion of PERSONAL DATA

A member may resign from all UNITS OF THE ORDER at any time. After it has processed such resignation(s) the ORDER shall archive the PERSONAL DATA for historical reference purposes and will stop the PERSONAL DATA from being used that it holds about that member as set out in The Data Protection Notice (Attachment A).

5. Sharing data with third parties

As a membership organisation the ORDER shares PERSONAL DATA of its members within the ADMINISTRATION as required by the CONSTITUTIONS or bodies it sanctions from time to time.

It will not share PERSONAL DATA of members for any other reason unless it has the consent of the relevant member.

6. Data Protection Notice

The ORDER shall publish a Data Protection Notice (Attachment A) so that it is available to members. The Data Protection Notice shall comply with the requirements of data protection law and among other things shall inform members how their PERSONAL DATA will be used by the ORDER and how they may contact the Data Protection Officer.

7. Data security

The ORDER shall periodically review the security of its records and processing activities and shall take appropriate steps to ensure the confidentiality, integrity and availability of PERSONAL DATA that it holds.

8. Social Media

No reference either by name or by photograph to any Brother is to be made on any form of social media without his express permission and that failure to adhere to this will be regarded as a Masonic Offence.

9. Registration with ICO

The ORDER as a non-profit organisation is exempt from registration with the ICO.

10. Data Protection Officer

The Data Protection Officer shall be the **GRAND SECRETARY**

11. Reporting breaches to the Data Protection Officer

Actual or potential breaches of this policy, or of data protection law by the PERSONAL DATA, shall be reported immediately to the Data Protection Officer. Breaches shall be reported if required by the Data Protection Officer to the ICO or to the member(s) whose data is affected. Normally the Data Protection Officer shall not report breaches without prior consultation with the HEAD OF THE ORDER.

ATTACHMENT A – DATA PROTECTION NOTICE

This notice is for all candidates and members of the ORDER and should be read in conjunction with the Data Protection Policy of the ORDER

It applies to the processing of your PERSONAL DATA by the ORDER.

Section I sets out the purposes for which your data will be used by the ORDER if you are a candidate to become a member of the ORDER.

Section II sets out the purposes for which your data will be used by the ORDER if you are a member of the ORDER.

Please note that your PERSONAL DATA will be processed by the ADMINISTRATION.

Section I - Use of your data during your application to become a member of the ORDER

As a candidate to become a member of the ORDER, you consent to the processing, retention and sharing of your personal data for the purpose of assessing your membership application and any other Masonic applications you may make.

You can withdraw your consent and request erasure of your data at any time prior to your admission into the ORDER by notifying your proposer and seconder that you wish to cancel your application.

Section II - Use of your data after you become a member of the ORDER

As a member of the ORDER your data will be processed, retained and shared for any reasonable purposes required by the CONSTITUTIONS or the bodies it sanctions from time to time. These purposes include, but are not limited to, the following purposes:

- a. Assessing any Masonic applications you make;
- b. Registering you as a member of the ORDER
- c. Receiving communications to which you are entitled a member of the ORDER.
- d. Recording the progress of your career in the ORDER; and
- e. Masonic disciplinary processes.

You may stop your data from being used by the ORDER by resigning from all UNIT(S) OF the ORDER.

Please contact Data Protection Officer if you wish to:

1. Object to the ORDER processing your data;
2. Request access to your data; or
3. Request rectification of your data.

DATA PROTECTION ACT.

Companions are reminded that the membership records of this Conclave include names, addresses and dates of birth and that these records are held on a computerised database held by this Conclave and Grand Conclave. Access to this information is regulated by the Data Protection Act.

SOCIAL MEDIA

No reference, either by name or by photograph, to any Companion is to be made on any form of social media without his express permission and that failure to adhere to this will be regarded as a Masonic Offence.

The legal bases on which your personal data will be used in accordance with this Section II are:

1. The legitimate interests of the ORDER as a not for profit membership organisation; and
2. The fulfilment of contractual obligations owed to you by the ORDER supported by the ADMINISTRATION

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED OF A CANDIDATES

34. A Candidate for admission into a Conclave shall be:

- i) a subscribing Past First Principal of a Royal Arch Chapter under the Supreme Grand Chapter of England or in amity therewith
- ii) a subscribing Past Master of a Craft Lodge under the United Grand Lodge of England. or in amity therewith.

He shall be proposed and seconded by two subscribing members of the Conclave and his Royal Arch Certificate shall have been produced to the Conclave Scribe.

No more than 3 Candidates may be received into the Order, at any one meeting of a Conclave, without prior Dispensation from the Grand Master.

25 To remain in regular membership of a Conclave, and, therefore of the Order, each member must remain a subscribing member of a Royal Arch Chapter under, or in amity with, The Supreme Grand Chapter of England and a subscribing Past Master of a Craft Lodge under, or in amity with, United Grand Lodge of England. Any member of the Order not complying with this requirement shall be deemed no longer to be a member of the Order and, therefore of any Conclave.
